President's Message

As we move toward a new year, I would like to take this opportunity to wish you all the best of God's Blessings for this holiday season and for a most prosperous New Year. I would also like to thank you for your support, words of encouragement and acts of kindness that you extended to Dorothy and me as we traveled around the ABA. You are truly appreciated.

If I were to make this a state of the ABA address, it would start with the ABA is well and financially stable. Thanks to you! We had two successful national tournaments that allowed us to meet all of our financial obligations.

Moving Forward With Your President

We were able to negotiate outsourcing the *Bulletin* and terminate the lease on the office printer that was costing about \$2200 a month. We were able to purchase a printer to meet our needs at a cost of about \$3600. This equates to a savings of about \$22,800 per year. This savings more than covers the cost of publishing the *Bulletin*. We have also published a new *Handbook*, but I must advise that this new *Handbook* has not yet been approved by your board of directors. The current approved version of the *Handbook* is the version dated in 2000. The 2006 version should be approved in Las Vegas. Please be aware and make sure that you are using the correct version as some things have changed.

We are losing members faster than we can acquire them and that makes membership recruitment our most

important objective. Marketing the ABA is equally important. We can't afford the expense necessary to adequately market our organization, so we have to depend on you, our members, to be the voices that advertise us. It doesn't matter what we do or recommend as your board of directors, you must be the liaison that makes anything work. As I campaigned for office, I promised full disclosure and my dedication, love for the ABA and personal integrity won't allow me to give you anything less than the best of me. I am not trying to paint a rosy picture of the ABA because as I write this article I know there is a virus eating at the very soul of our existence and it must be addressed. Master Points!

What are master points? They are rewards for winning, placing or showing in a bridge event. They have become the life's blood to some of our members who have spent long years and many thousands of dollars accumulating them. I only say this for you to know that I understand their importance. I promised that we would revisit and reevaluate the master point conversion project. This is being done thanks to all of your shared concerns and will be addressed at our Spring National in Las Vegas. The ACBL programmers have been extremely supportive, making adjustments to their scoring program to better accommodate the ABA. Our staff directors have been working extremely hard training directors to be prepared to electronically submit

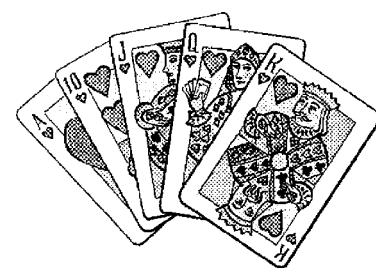

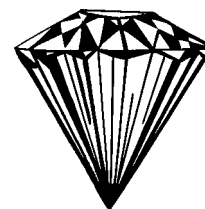

sanctioned game results to the National office beginning January 1, 2007. Several myths are being circulated to our members and I must address them also.

First, the ABA is not going to merge with the ACBL. Yes, they have been very supportive and have provided us with a great scoring program at no cost. But, the American Bridge Association has a long and proud history and this administration is dedicated to maintaining that heritage. Secondly, it is through the continued efforts of the ACBL programmers that we are able to revisit our master point program. Change is inevitable, even the ACBL is changing the way they evaluate playing ability and it won't be simply on master point holdings. We have a chance to be on the cutting edge, right along with the ACBL in evaluating a player's ability and the competitive level at which they play the game.

As many of you may know, next year (2007) is an election year and I will be a candidate for re-election.
