She had an adventurous spirit and spent a year working in Hawaii for the thrill and experience. In 1950 she married Army officer K. Bedayan and had 3 daughters. She later earned a nursing degree and worked as a RN. Barbara was very outgoing and loved helping people. She cared deeply about the underprivileged and gave her resources to help. She valued family and friends and kept in touch with the special people in her life. She enjoyed golf, traveling, and had a passion for Bridge, which she taught and directed both locally and occasionally aboard cruise ships. She recently achieved the high status of Gold Life Master. Barbara was a member of Bellevue Presbyterian Church, lived at the Park Shore Retirement Community for the past 10 years and enjoyed an active lifestyle. She was diagnosed with lung cancer in January and passed away 6 weeks later, a week before her 88th birthday.
